



Situation Report -2: Landslide in Maharashtra

7th August, 2014

A. SITUATION REPORT:

The rescue and the relief operation that was launched on 30th July, 2014 due to landslide trigger by heavy rainfall at Malin village in Pune, district of Ambegaon has been declared officially over on 6th August, 2014 after eight days of the catastrophe. The final death toll was put at 151 with eight survivors.

C. RESPONSE FROM GOVERNMENT AND HUMANITARIAN AGENCIES:

- The state government has announced an assistance of Rs 5 lakh to relatives or families of the affected victims with complete rehabilitation.
- Affected villagers have been sheltered by the district administration at "Ashram Shalas" in an adjacent village.
- The authorities have also asked remaining residents in the village to shift to safer places following an advisory of Geological Survey of India (GSI) officials as there is likelihood of further landslide as heavy rain continue.
- Assistance provided by humanitarian agencies not reported.
