

Situation Report -2: Uttar Pradesh Flood

A. Situation Report

The heavy rainfall in Nepal and Uttarakhand has created flood situation in the state of Uttar Pradesh. The situations of major rivers are as below—

- Sharda river is flowing 0.040 mt above danger mark at Paliyakalan
- Rapti river is flowing 0.330 mt above danger mark at Gorakhpur and 1.80 mt. above danger mark at sidharth nagar
- Water level in the Sharda at Paliyankalan and Rapti at Gorakhpur is increasing.

- The NDRF, SSB and PAC are deployed for immediate relief and rescue in the affected areas. Boats have been deployed in the area for search and rescue operation.
- Medical teams have been deployed in the region to cater medical needs of the people.
- Food and non food items is being distributed by govt. to the effected population.
- Cleaning of the villages and chlorination and disinfection of water resources is being carried out where water has been receded.
- Government is still running camps where water is not receded.
- UP IAG has conducted a Joint Rapid Needs Assessment and report will be circulated soon.
