D. HUMANITARIAN RESPONSE TO THE DISEASE

Government Response:

- The Ministry has announced Rs 4 lakh compensation for the families of those killed due to the virus on 14th March 2020. More info can be accessed at http://www.mohfw.gov.in/UseofSDRFofCOVID19.pdf
- Additional quarantine facilities, development of isolation wards, training of health workers & doctors being undertaken by the States/UTs to fight the spread of virus.
- Ministry of Health along with state government and NDMA is disseminating Do's and Don'ts and travel advisory on COVID 19 to public through social media.
- Ministry of Health have activated the Helpline Number for corona-virus: +91-11-23978046



- As per the order of Delhi Government all primary schools will be closed until 31st of March.
- Goa and West Bengal government also came forward to fight coronavirus as it announced shutdown of educational institution until 31st of March.
- Health Ministry reported that 21 stranded Indians in Italy reached Kerala.
- West Bengal has shut its border with Bhutan amid virus case.
- Delhi govt bans sports gatherings, including IPL amid the coronavirus threat
- BCCI has pushed forward IPL date by a fortnight.
- Government has issued directive to telecom companies to make a pre-call announcement on Coronavirus while making a call.
- Government has also disabled biometrics for employees in both public and private offices from 6th of March until 31st October.
- NDMA convened a meeting of Civil Society organizations to brainstorm and strategize the role of civil society in preparedness and response to COVID 19 in India.

- World Vision has started community preparedness and printing IEC materials.
- Sphere India also conducted a meeting with Health Ministry of the state on 13th March to assess the situation and make use of government machinery in creating preparedness.
- WHO has activated the R&D blueprint to accelerate diagnostics, vaccines, and therapeutics.
- WHO has developed interim guidelines for laboratory diagnosis, advice on use of masks during home care and in health care settings.
