Background:

Several colonies and low-lying areas in Dimapur were flooded after heavy rains in the early hours of June 11, affecting hundreds of families.

SITUATION UPDATE AND RESPONSE

- On Sunday, June 11, several colonies in and around Dimapur experienced severe flooding, causing significant disruption and affecting hundreds of families.
- The areas worst affected by the floods included Zeliangrongram colony, Master colony, Netaji colony, Medical colony, Vilhume colony, Lake View colony, Lengrijan, Ao Yimsen, Borlengri, Nepali Kashiram, Burma Camp (Rainbow colony), Walford colony, Police colony, Island colony, low-lying areas of Indisen village, Duncan Basti, and the Super Market area.
- There were no reported casualties resulting from the floods.
- In certain areas, vehicles were submerged under water, while most regions experienced water levels reaching waist-deep.
- The floods caused extensive damage to personal property, kitchen utensils, household appliances, and other belongings.
- Approximately 150 individuals from Police Colony sought refuge in Salt Christian College due to their houses being damaged or submerged.

HUMANITARIAN RESPONSE

Government Preparedness and Response

Preparedness:

IMD has predicted Widespread light/moderate rainfall with isolated Heavy to Very Heavy falls very likely over the region during the next 5 days.

Response:

- Nagaland State Disaster Management Authority team, along with district administration and DMC visited the affected areas to assess the situation.
- A team of 43 Assam Rifle personnel provided food to the affected people at Vilhume and SM colony
