SITUATION UPDATE AND RESPONSE

Situation in Uttarakhand and Himachal Pradesh

- A cloudburst occurred in Raipur block of Uttarakhand's Dehradun district on Saturday morning
- Water entered the caves of Tapkeshwar, a famous Shiva temple on the banks of the Tons river
- Kangra district received the highest rainfall of 346.6 mm during the last 24 hours in Himachal. Dharamsala recorded 333 mm, Mandi 119.6 mm, Dalhousie 111 mm, Palampur 113 mm, Sundernagar 77.7 mm, Barthin 60, Shimla 57.7 mm and Kufri 69 mm of rainOn Sunday, Madurai, Sivaganga, Thoothukudi, Theni, Dindigul, The Nilgiris, and parts of Coimbatore received heavy rainfall.
- There has been a heavy landslide from the hill near Kamand on Mandi-Bajora via Kataula road. The district administration has banned the movement of traffic on the route at night itself.
- It was informed that 742 roads, 2000 electric transformers and 172 drinking water schemes have been stalled across the state.
- Transport services were disrupted on more than 650 routes on Friday due to the closure of roads.
- In Mandi, NH Mandi-Pathankot, Mandi-Kullu and Mandi-Jalandhar via Dharampur remain closed throughout the day.
- In Odisha, nearly four lakh people in 500 villages are already reeling under the floodwaters in the Mahanadi river basin.
- A railway bridge over Chakki river in Himachal Pradesh's Kangra district has collapsed due to floods.
- National Highway 5 between Shimla and Kalka has been blocked and traffic has been diverted via Shogi Mehli Bypass as stones are still falling actively, Shimla Police said.
- A bridge across the Song River near Thano was washed away. Kempty Falls, a popular tourist destination near Mussoorie, is also flowing dangerously.
- The cloudburst inundated houses in more than a dozen villages, including Maldevta, Bhutsi, Thauliakathal, Tatyud, Lawarkha, Ringalgad, Dhutu, Ragadgaon and Sarkhet.
- In Uttarakhand, the affected people were shifted to schools and panchayat buildings
- Kalsi river Amlav (Ganga basin) in Dehradun district is flowing in extreme flood situation with steady trend.



🛱 Government Preparedness and Response

Preparedness:

IMD has issued a warning of Fairly widespread/widespread light/moderate rainfall with isolated heavy falls and thunderstorms/lightning in Himachal Pradesh during 20 to -24th, Uttarakhand on 20th, 21st & 24th August. According to the weather bulletin issued by the India Meteorological Department (IMD) on August 20th, no red alert has been declared in Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand

As per IMD Press Release dated 20th August, Isolated very heavy rainfall was also likely over Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand on 20th August, 2022.

The Himachal Pradesh's disaster management department has issued a warning for landslide due to heavy rains predicted in the state till August 25.

CWC issued Alert for water level rise associated with flash floods may be kept in rivers Satiuj, Tons, Beas and its tributaries in districts Hamirpur, Bilaaspur, Champa, Kangra, Mandi, Solan, Shimla and Sirmaur districts, and keep alert for flash flood occurrences in Gauri Ganga, Ramganga, Kali, Alaknanda and other tributaries of upper Ganga basin in Uttarakhand.

Response:

- SDRF and NDRF have managed to rescue and evacuate 15 people missing in heavy rains in last 24 hours and 5 dead bodies have been recovered.
- Chief Minister of Himachal Pradesh Mr. Jairam Thakur Concern was expressed over the heavy loss of life and property caused by the rains in various parts of the state. The Chief Minister directed the district administration to ensure immediate relief, rescue and rehabilitation activities in the affected areas.
- Uttarakhand CM Pushkar Singh Dhami takes stock of the situation unfolding in state amid heavy rains. He also enquired about the ongoing relief work in affected areas.
- Minister Shri Swamiku held a meeting with the Department Chief Secretary, all Directors, all District Agriculture Officers, District Animal Welfare Officers and Field Officers through video conference to discuss the situation due to floods and torrential rains.






