SITUATION UPDATE AND RESPONSE

Situation in Uttar Pradesh

- 37 villages of 05 districts and 15602 people in Uttar Pradesh are affected due to flood during last 24 hrs.
- Ghagra river at Elginbridge, Ayodhya, Turtipar Rohin river at Trimohinighat, Ganga river at Kachhlabridge, Rapti river at Balrampur, Kwano river at Chandradeepghat, and Sarda river at Paliakalan are flowing above the danger mark.
- Chief Minister instructed the officials of Gonda, Basti, Ambedkar Nagar, Sant Kabir Nagar, Gorakhpur, Azamgarh, Deoria, Mau, Ballia, and Ayodhya to be on alert in view of the possible threat of floods
- The advisory also mentioned staying away from open sewers, electric wires and poles and contacting Municipal Corporation Control Room for any civic problem like water logging, tree fall
- Helpline No. 1912 for electrical faults etc. In case of any medical emergency contact Chief Medical Officer, Lucknow Control Room at 0522-2622080. Also, an Integrated Control Command Center number for any other issues is listed in the advisory--register an issue at 0522- 4523000.
- Government hospitals, Public and community health centres (PHCs) and (CHCs) are advised to stay on high alert.
- Officers and employees posted in emergency services were also advised to be present on duty. Arrangement of medicines, patient vehicles etc, should also be ensured.
- Heavy rainfall in Lucknow led to the waterlogging in streets and damage to trees. In one incident, a wall collapsed in Lucknow due to rain, leading to deaths of nine people

Government Preparedness and Response

Preparedness:

IMD has issued a warning of Widespread light/moderate rainfall with isolated heavy falls & thunderstorm/lightning very likely over Uttarakhand on 19 th and over south East Uttar Pradesh on 21st September, 2022. There are no red alerts issued by IMD for Uttar Pradesh during 20th to 24th September 2022.

CWC issued Severe flood alert for Ghaghra river in Barabanki, Ballia, Ayodhya districts, Rohin river in Maharajganj district, Kwano river in Gonda district, Ganga river in Budaun district and Rapti river in Rapti district in 19th September 2022

Response:

- CM Yogi has also instructed to release a relief amount of Rs 4 lakh to the families of the deceased. He also instructed for proper treatment of all the injured. Instructions were given to give relief amounts to all the kin of the dead from the disaster relief fund.
- 10 teams of National Disaster Response Force has been deployed in Uttar Pradesh.
